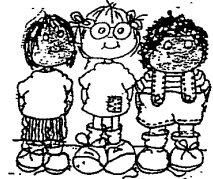


## "Little Ups"

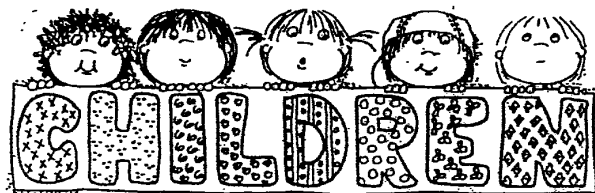
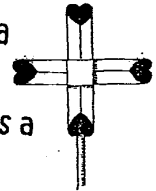

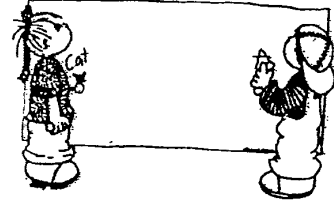
## November Stars of the Month
