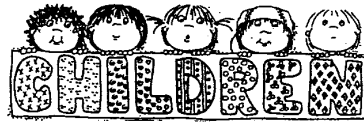
Food for Kids

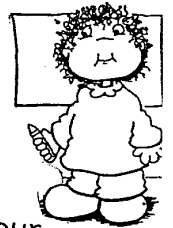


Gallery display in Reception Room

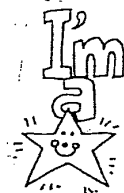

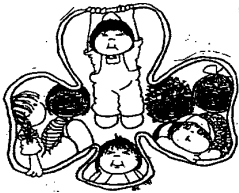
Youth News

"Little ups"



In the Grade 3-5 classroom led by Sharyn Laughton and Meredith Perkins a "Godly Play" Advent Story recently centered around the light of the prophets being like the flame on a candle. When we snuff out the candle the light changes but, I wonder how? One of the children said, "yes the light is released for everyone." In the PreK-Grade 2 class the flame (light) was snuffed out and the smoke moves everywhere. The children, knowing the flame represents the light of the prophets open the classroom doors so the light (smoke) can go upstairs to the church where their parents are. The children all grab the light and put it in their pockets, so it is with them always. Note the different interpretation by the ages as they listen and wonder about the stories over and over. Does that happen to us over the years? I think-yes.
