CHS Planning Study To Begin

- As mentioned at our Annual Meeting and at church today, our Vestry is committed to expanding our mission and ministry. One key step in achieving this goal is the addition of another priest to our parish. This expansion will allow us to enhance pastoral care, broaden our welcome to newcomers, and strengthen parish programming—benefiting both our congregation and the wider community in Orleans and surrounding towns.
- To support this initiative, we are focusing on:
 - Increasing our endowment to ensure our operating budget can sustain the addition of a new clergy member.
 - Enhancing our campus facilities to better accommodate church activities and community events.
- Careful planning and thoughtful consideration are essential before moving forward, which is why your input is invaluable. Your feedback will help shape a final plan that aligns with both our parish’s vision and financial capacity.
- To guide this process, we have engaged Cornerstone Fundraising, a professional religious fundraising firm, to conduct a Planning Study. Over the next several weeks, every registered parishioner will be invited to participate in this study through interviews, parish-wide focus groups, and an online survey.
- We encourage you to actively participate in this process. Your insights and honest feedback will be instrumental in shaping the future of our parish.
